



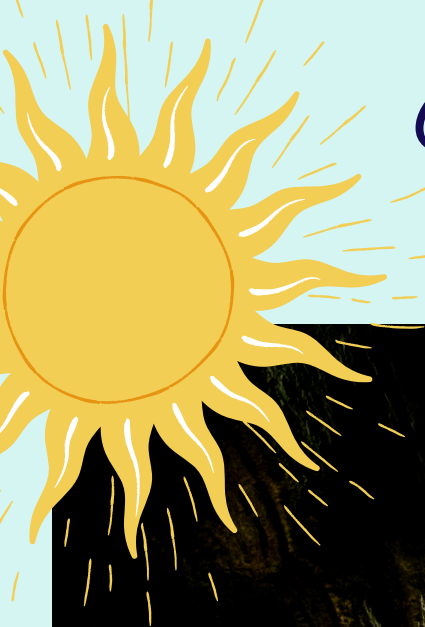

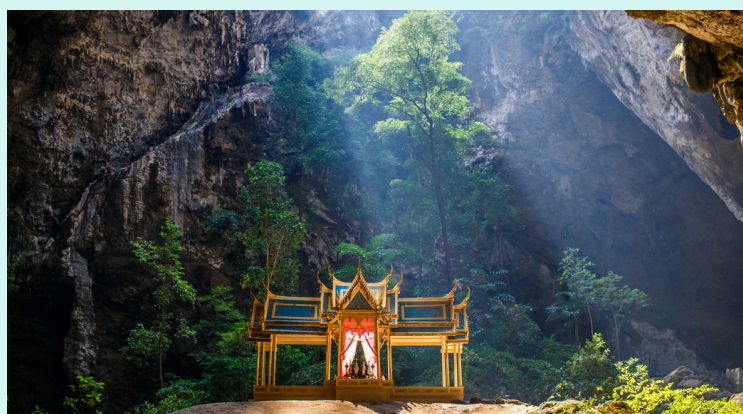

Gem #1: Thailand Phraya Nakon Cave

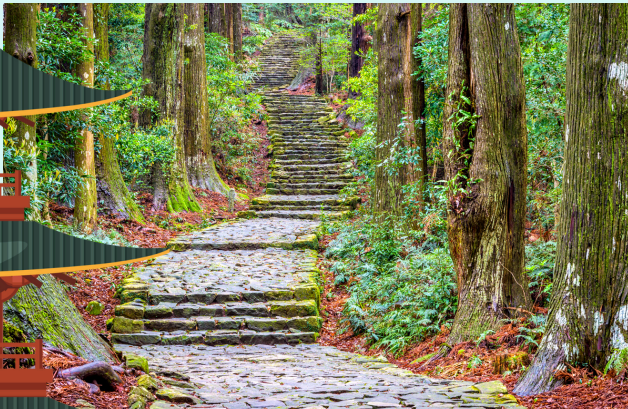
